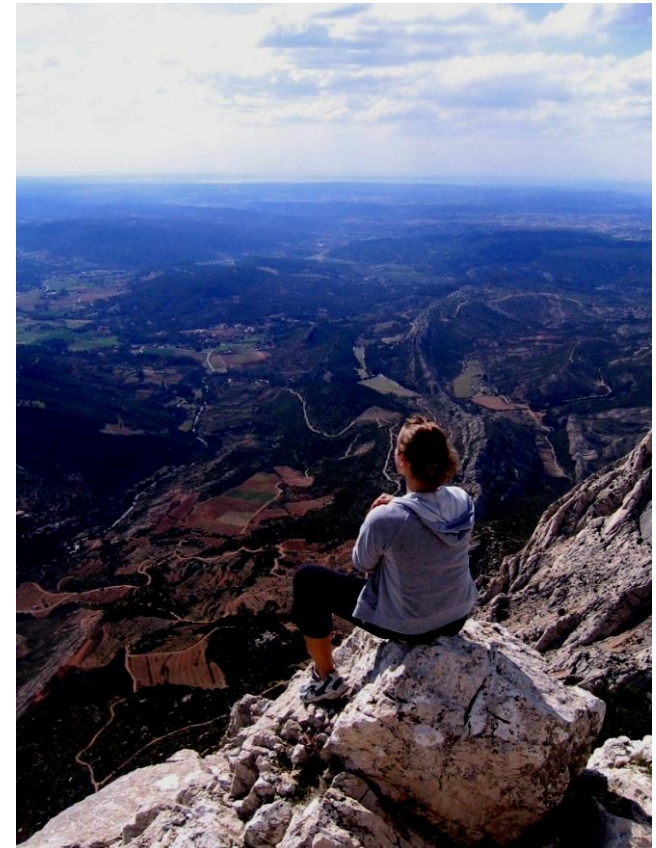


INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS
