- 2 _____ DS-2019 Application for an Exchange Student Form.
- 3 _____ Certification of Financial Support Form: Refer to the Estimated Budget for 2010-11 document for specific costs that must be listed. This form requires a bank signature and official seal. All documents included with the Certification of Financial Support must be originals.
- 4 _____ Personal statement (one page typed) outlining your academic goals and listing classes (including academic departments) you wish to attend while at the UW-Madison.
- 5 _____ TOEFL score test results (a recommended minimum score of 550 paper, 213 computer version or 80 internet based) or evidence of English proficiency level (letter on letterhead from college/university English professor).
- 6 _____ Original university transcript or other record of university level courses taken and grades received.
- 7 _____ If you need disability services that will require special accommodations while studying in Madison, please include documentation of your disability and any accommodations that are made at your home institution. Please bring an additional set of these materials with you to Madison.
- 8 _____ Health and Wellness Form. This information will not impact the admission decision.
- 9 _____ Transcript Release Form.
