Limits and Load

You will enroll in a full-time academic program. You are required to take a language course – Hindi, Urdu, or Telugu and can choose your other three courses from course offerings at the University of Hyderabad or courses for international students through the “Study in India Program (SIP)”.

Credits

Total recommended credit for the semester is 16 credits and total recommended credit for the academic year is 32 credits. Credits are one to one.

Grades and Grade Conversions

The majority of classes have two mid-semester examinations worth 20% each, and one final exam worth 60%. Some classes also have short quizzes, homework assignments, seminars, tutorials, and term papers. The final result in each course is calculated on the basis of this continuous assessment.
